

## **CV NÉSTOR DANIEL ROSELLI**

Nestor Daniel Roselli Phd. obtained his degree in Psychology at Universidad Nacional de Rosario (Argentina) in 1968. . He obtained his Phd in Université de Louvain (Belgium) in 1977 and specialized in Experimental Social Psychology at Universiteit Te Leuven.

In 1980 he entered Argentina's National Council of Research on Science and Technology (CONICET) where he has developed his career ever since and has obtained the highest degree in research (Investigador Principal).

Dr Roselli was the head researcher and director of the Research Institute on Education of Rosario (IRICE), which is one of CONICET's main research institutes, for 16 years. His work in this institute was in the field of educational sciences and the study of socio-cognitive processes in learning. For the last 20 years his main research topic has been socio-cognitive interactions in learning environments, including collaborative learning.

He currently directs the Centro de Investigaciones en Psicología y Psicopedagogía (CIPP) at Argentina's Catholic University (UCA) and teaches several courses in different Master degrees and Phds. In addition he is member of various scientific and editorial boards of different Psychology and Education Journals.
